

Dear Mission Minded Churches,

As you know we are still in the process of raising money for Books for Pastors., and as I sit here in my own library. looking at the vast amount of resources I have to study and exegete the Word with, I am ashamed that I haven't done more this vear to promote the cause of raising funds for Pastors in need. Some Pastors are preaching with just a page of the Bible or a

few chapters at best. Others have two or three books in their resource library.

How can we, a nation of fortunate pastors assist our brothers and sisters in need? Glad you asked me, because I'll be glad to tell you. This year we are looking to make it more personal. So we have asked all churches on the district to adopt a country. Some churches already adopted a country, at District Assembly. For those who did not, I will be appointing a country for you to support. I will send out information the first week of July on your individual countries, and how you can raise the money to help buy books for pastors.

I would also encourage you to get your people involved in supporting their country by showing the video periodically, as well as having fundraisers, and special offerings. The church that raises the most for books for pastors will receive special recognition at our next District Assembly.

We also recommend getting film canisters to hand out to your congregation, to help support this cause. Each film canister holds seven dollars in quarters, and this would be an easy way to get the individual members of your congregation involved in filling up the canisters. Film canisters can be obtained at Wal-Mart, Walgreen's, CVS, and BJ's. All you need to do is ask what the best pick up day is.


The date for the trip is November 10—19th, 2006.




